## Psalm 14

## A Psalm of David

King James Version (KJV)

- **14** The <u>fool</u> hath said in his heart, there is no God. They are corrupt, they have done abominable works, there is none that doeth good. (fool= stupid & impious)
- <sup>2</sup>The LORD looked down from heaven upon the children of men, to see if there were any that did understand, and seek God.
- <sup>3</sup>They are all gone aside, they are all together become <u>filthy</u>: there is none that doeth good, no, not one. (filthy= stinky)
- <sup>4</sup> Have all the workers of iniquity no knowledge? who eat up my people as they eat bread, and call not upon the LORD.
- There were they in great <u>fear</u>: for God is in the generation of the righteous. (fear= fear & revere... Gods enemies should fear Him, His servants revere Him)
- <sup>6</sup>Ye have shamed the counsel of the <u>poor</u>, because the LORD is his refuge. (poor= also means the oppressed)
- <sup>7</sup>Oh that the salvation of Israel were come out of Zion! when the LORD bringeth back the captivity of his people, <u>Jacob</u> shall rejoice, and Israel shall be glad. (<u>Jacob</u> is used in reference to all 12 tribes)
