

Ephesians 6

King James Version (KJV)

(Ephesians = the permitted)

(A deeper teaching about the three Ages, and how to walk through life as a mature Christian)

6 Children, obey your parents in the Lord: for this is right. (God's Word is built on common sense. Our parents can teach us what we need to know to find our way in the world. Christian parents can also teach us what is truly important for us to know and what is not)

² Honour thy father and mother; which is the first commandment with promise; (It is the fifth commandment of the ten. – It is the first Commandment that can promise of a long happy life)

³ That it may be well with thee, and thou mayest live long on the earth. See Exodus-20:12

NOTE: (See the Ten Commandments at the end of this chapter)

⁴ And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord. (That will get you their respect and their love. They will honor you as a parent)

⁵ Servants, be obedient to them that are your masters according to the flesh, with fear and trembling, in singleness of your heart, as unto Christ; (If you are hired to do a job, do it the best you can. When you do a good job, you will be eventually promoted to better and better jobs)

⁶ Not with eyeservice, as menpleasers; but as the servants of Christ, doing the will of God from the heart; (Don't be a hypocrite and a yes man. Work for others as you would work for God. Be a good example to others and you will find plenty of employment opportunities)

⁷ With good will doing service, as to the Lord, and not to men: (Live your life as if you were working for God. Follow God's Word, not men's doctrines)

⁸ Knowing that whatsoever good thing any man doeth, the same shall he receive of the Lord, whether he be bond or free. (God rewards those who live, work and invest honestly. God blesses those riches; as much as He hates ill gotten gains. HE curses ill gotten gains)

⁹ And, ye masters, do the same things unto them, forbearing threatening: knowing that your Master also is in heaven; neither is there respect of persons with him. (When you hire people to work for you, treat them well and pay them well; just as you would want God to treat you. God has no favorites. HE treats everyone equally, as they deserve to be treated)

¹⁰ Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might. (Be strong as a Christian in order to make a difference in the world. The right hand of God is very powerful)

¹¹ Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. (wiles = deceit, lies, false accusations, treachery, etc)

(You don't put on armor in order to fly. Our duties are not to fly away in some made up rapture doctrine. We will be called to testify against antichrist and his one world system. The Gospel armor is there to protect us from the fiery darts of Satan. He will slander us and try to ruin our good name) Matthew-24, Mark-13 and Ezekiel-13:17-22

NOTE: (We see the beginnings of that already with liberals calling Christians "right wing radicals" who need to be censored. Some of those on the left are even calling for imprisonment of Christians who haven't committed any crimes. They call this "red flag laws". They want to preemptively take away the rights of law abiding Christians)

¹² For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places. (This will be a spiritual war. Anrichrist will come in peacefully and prosperously. He will deceive the whole world into believing that he is messiah. They will worship him)

(Christians will defeat Satan's one world religious system through their testimony. The words that the Holy Spirit will speak through the Elect will wake people up; out of their stupor. They will then turn against Satan; and his system will collapse on itself) Daniel-8:23-28

¹³ Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. (The armor of God will protect the Elect against Satan when they testify before the whole world. The world will hate them for it)

NOTE: (We are already seeing the beginnings of it today with political correctness, woke intersectionalism & inclusivity. Good is good, and bad is bad. That is the truth. The truth cannot be changed by propaganda)

¹⁴ Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness; (Truth = moral correctness; not political correctness. The truth that is in God's Word)

(righteousness – knowing right from wrong)

¹⁵ And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace; (Know the Word of God and be prepared for Satan's lies. Stand firm)

¹⁶ Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked. (Antichrist will accuse Christians of anything he can think of, and people will believe him. Don't let the world destroy your faith in God. Be a pleaser of God; not of man)

¹⁷ And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God:

Revelation-1:16-17 (The two edged sword that came out of Jesus' mouth is the Word of God. The truth will cut through Satan's lies and deception)

¹⁸ Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints; (Pray to God that you will be strong enough to do His will when you are delivered up to the synagogue of Satan; and God will strengthen you with His power)

¹⁹ And for me, that utterance may be given unto me, that I may open my mouth boldly, to make known the mystery of the gospel, (God will speak through us when delivered before antichrist. God will speak the cloven tongue that will be understood by all people in all languages, at the same time; as is written in the Book of Joel)

²⁰ For which I am an ambassador in bonds: that therein I may speak boldly, as I ought to speak. (Paul as a Bible teacher was in fact an ambassador for God to us. He was in prison for having taught God's Word; not for having committed any criminal offence)

²¹ But that ye also may know my affairs, and how I do, Tychicus, a beloved brother and faithful minister in the Lord, shall make known to you all things: (Tychicus must have been at Ephesus to teach the people in Paul's absence. Paul was wrongly locked up in Rome)

²² Whom I have sent unto you for the same purpose, that ye might know our affairs, and that he might comfort your hearts. (To teach the Word of God, to comfort the people and give them peace of mind)

²³ Peace be to the brethren, and love with faith, from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. (Knowing God's Word brings peace of mind)

²⁴ Grace be with all them that love our Lord Jesus Christ in sincerity. Amen. (A blessing to all of God's faithful servants)
