

Matthew 1

King James Version (KJV)

(Matthew was a tax collector. He is called Levi in Mark-4)

1 The book of the generation of Jesus Christ, the son of David, the son of Abraham. (Matthew = gift of Yah)

NOTE: (Matthew got it right. Jesus is God; not his son. God begat Himself, through Mary, as a flesh man. Matthew calls Jesus the son of David. Jesus always referred to Himself as the son of man. Men called Him the son of God)

Isaiah-7:14 (Immanuel = God with us)

Genesis-1:26 (God said – Let us make man in our image. HE included Himself in that statement. HE created Jesus in His image. Through God's power, we created our flesh bodies in our image)

John-1-1 (The Living Word was with God, and the Word was God. Jesus is that Living Word – God in the flesh)

John-14 (Jesus said – If you've seen Me, you've seen the Father)

²Abraham begat Isaac; and Isaac begat Jacob; and Jacob begat Judas and his brethren; (This genealogy is for Joseph – Jesus' step father. Jesus genealogy is through Mary) see Luke-3

Samuel-12:8 (God promised Abraham that the Messiah <God in the flesh> would come through his progeny)

³And Judas begat Phares and Zara of Thamar; and Phares begat Esrom; and Esrom begat Aram; (Judas<Greek> = Judah<Hebrew>)

⁴And Aram begat Aminadab; and Aminadab begat Naasson; and Naasson begat Salmon;

⁵And Salmon begat Booz of Rachab; and Booz begat Obed of Ruth; and Obed begat Jesse; (Booz<Greek> = Boaz<Hebrew> It's the same name in 2 different languages)

(This woman Ruth is the same as in the Book of Ruth. She was King David's great grandmother)

⁶And Jesse begat David the king; and David the king begat Solomon of her that had been the wife of Urias; (Solomon is in the seed line of Joseph. Mary's seed line came through King David's son Nathan)

⁷And Solomon begat Roboam; and Roboam begat Abia; and Abia begat Asa;

⁸And Asa begat Josaphat; and Josaphat begat Joram; and Joram begat Ozias;

⁹And Ozias begat Joatham; and Joatham begat Achaz; and Achaz begat Ezekias;

¹⁰And Ezekias begat Manasses; and Manasses begat Amon; and Amon begat Josias;

¹¹And Josias begat Jechonias and his brethren, about the time they were carried away to Babylon:

¹²And after they were brought to Babylon, Jechonias begat Salathiel; and Salathiel begat Zorobabel;

¹³And Zorobabel begat Abiud; and Abiud begat Eliakim; and Eliakim begat Azor;

¹⁴And Azor begat Sadoc; and Sadoc begat Achim; and Achim begat Eliud;

¹⁵And Eliud begat Eleazar; and Eleazar begat Matthan; and Matthan begat Jacob;

¹⁶And Jacob begat Joseph the husband of Mary, of whom was born Jesus, who is called Christ. (Jesus = Immanuel = God with us)

NOTES: (Joseph was only Jesus' step father - by adoption. Mary conceived Jesus by God's grace as a virgin. God became man through Mary's womb through divine intervention) Luke-3

(Mary's genealogy is written in Luke-3. Mary's mother was of Levi <Priest line>, as documented by her cousin Elizabeth in Luke-1. And her father was of Judah <King line> as documented in Luke-3. So, Jesus was the merger of the priest line and the king line. That's why Jesus holds the title of - King of kings, Lord of lords)

(Joseph <Jesus' step father> came through Solomon descendants. Jesus came through Nathan's descendants. Jesus and Joseph were only related through adoption)

¹⁷ So all the generations from Abraham to David are fourteen generations; and from David until the carrying away into Babylon are fourteen generations; and from the carrying away into Babylon unto Christ are fourteen generations.

¹⁸ Now the birth of Jesus Christ was on this wise: When as his mother Mary was espoused to Joseph, before they came together, she was found with child of the Holy Ghost. (Mary was a virgin carrying a child)

¹⁹ Then Joseph her husband, being a just man, and not willing to make her a public example, was minded to put her away privily. (By Jewish law she could have been convicted of adultery and executed)

²⁰ But while he thought on these things, behold, the angel of the LORD appeared unto him in a dream, saying, Joseph, thou son of David, fear not to take unto thee Mary thy wife: for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Ghost. (God came to Joseph in angelic form in order to explain what was happening through Mary. God was using Mary in order to come into the world as a flesh man)

²¹ And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name JESUS: for he shall save his people from their sins. (Jesus = Yahoveh's savior)

²² Now all this was done, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken of the Lord by the prophet, saying,

²³ Behold, a virgin shall be with child, and shall bring forth a son, and they shall call his name Emmanuel, which being interpreted is, God with us. (Emanuel <Greek = Immanuel <Hebrew> = God with us <English>)

See Isaiah-7:14 (This prophecy was made 700 years earlier)

See Genesis-1:26-28 (God said - Let us make man in OUR image. God made Jesus in His image. We made our flesh bodies in our image - the image of our spiritual bodies in the First Age)

²⁴ Then Joseph being raised from sleep did as the angel of the Lord had bidden him, and took unto him his wife: (the angel of the Lord = God

in angelic form; God took many forms throughout history; Yahoveh, the Holy Spirit, Jesus, the angel of the Lord, Melchizedek, etc.)

NOTE: (The concept of the trinity was invented by the early Catholic Church. Unfortunately this teaching of man has caused other religions to falsely think that Christians worship three gods as a trinity. There is only one God. He can take any form that He chooses)

²⁵ And knew her not till she had brought forth her firstborn son: and he called his name JESUS. (Joseph obeyed God. He was a good man)
(Jesus = Yahoveh's savior, Yah does save)
