

2 John 1

King James Version (KJV)

¹The elder unto the elect lady and her children, whom I love in the truth; and not I only, but also all they that have known the truth; (The elect lady & her children are Israel. The truth is all in God's Word, chapter by chapter, verse by verse. God loves those who take the time to study and understand it)

See Revelation-19 (The bride of Christ)

²For the truth's sake, which dwelleth in us, and shall be with us for ever. (God's Word never changes. If you learn the truth, you will know it forever)

³Grace be with you, mercy, and peace, from God the Father, and from the Lord Jesus Christ, the Son of the Father, in truth and love. (These are all the same God, in different forms. The early church created the trinity. But the truth is that God has manifested Himself to us in more forms than just the trinity – such as Melchizedek, the Angel of the Lord, etc)

NOTES: (The reason that it will be Jesus, who will judge us in the Millennium, is because He is God in the flesh. We are being judged for what we did in the flesh. God, as Jesus, lived a flesh life in this world. HE is qualified to judge our behavior, because He did it also)

(In the great white throne judgment after the Millennium, those who need to make the second resurrection will be judged by God as Himself – the form that Jesus called the Father) see Revelation-20:5-11

⁴I rejoiced greatly that I found of thy children walking in truth, as we have received a commandment from the Father. (They taught their children the Word of God, as John had taught them. The truth sets us free by giving us peace of mind. God is the King of Peace) John-8:32

⁵And now I beseech thee, lady, not as though I wrote a new commandment unto thee, but that which we had from the beginning, that we love one another. (There was an Age before this one. We will remember it after we leave our flesh bodies. We will have total recall when we are back in our spiritual bodies) John-1:1

(Peter also spoke of it also in 2Peter-3)

⁶And this is love, that we walk after his commandments. This is the commandment, That, as ye have heard from the beginning, ye should walk in it. (Good love for the good, tough love for the wicked. The Ten Commandments are the law – given to us by God) Exodus-20

(Ignore the political correctness of the world. It is all nonsense. Live by the law. Do not just talk about it; do it in your daily life)

⁷For many deceivers are entered into the world, who confess not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh. This is a deceiver and an antichrist. (These false teachers are a type for Satan; when he will be cast out of heaven as antichrist. These include atheists, false Christian preachers, Muslim clerics and teachers of other religions) Mark-13, Matthew-24

(Jesus said – I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me) John-14:6

⁸Look to yourselves, that we lose not those things which we have wrought, but that we receive a full reward. (They outnumber us. Do not be deceived by the majority. Stay true to the Word of God, even when the world will hate you for it. Keep your eye on the prize and be patient) see 2Thessalonians 2:1-3

⁹Whosoever transgresseth, and abideth not in the doctrine of Christ, hath not God. He that abideth in the doctrine of Christ, he hath both the Father and the Son. (The Son is the Father, in flesh form – One God, many offices)

Isaiah-7:14 (God asked us to go through the flesh, and so did He. God never asks us to do something that He wouldn't also do. The difference is that He did it perfectly, without sin) see Genesis-1:26

¹⁰If there come any unto you, and bring not this doctrine, receive him not into your house, neither bid him God speed: (Do not enable anyone who teaches a doctrine that is different than that which Jesus taught us. The truth is absolute; not "inclusive" of politically correct adaptations)

¹¹For he that biddeth him God speed is partaker of his evil deeds. (Don't wish a good day to false doctrine. The truth is absolute – right or wrong. There is no gray area)

¹²Having many things to write unto you, I would not write with paper and ink: but I trust to come unto you, and speak face to face, that our

joy may be full. (Teaching face to face is always better than writing because it is interactive. You can answer peoples' questions. But if it's not possible, then teaching by written word is a good substitute)

¹³ The children of thy elect sister greet thee. Amen.
