

Revelation 21

King James Version (KJV)

(The Millennium is passed. The great Judgment has been pronounced. Satan and the evil ones have died. This is the Third Age – the eternity)

21 And I saw a new heaven and a new earth: for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away; and there was no more sea. (new = rejuvenated, refreshed – better translation)

(This is the Third Age – a new heaven age and a new earth age. All people are in spiritual bodies. All evil is gone)

²And I John saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.
Ezekiel-16 (God wed Jerusalem)

(New Jerusalem is where God will live with us forever. We are all in a different dimension – a spiritual <non-corporeal> dimension without flesh bodies. What happens in the rest of the universe is irrelevant to us. We will have put on immortality) 1Corinthians-50-57

³And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and he will dwell with them, and they shall be his people, and God himself shall be with them, and be their God. (Heaven will be on earth. No more men ruling over other men. God will rule all people justly and fairly)

⁴And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away. (There will be no memory of those who didn't make it to heaven. That's why there will be no more tears or sorrow. Their souls died, and the lake of fire will no longer exist)

See Ezekiel-28:18-19 (Satan and all the damned who followed him will no longer exist)

⁵And he that sat upon the throne said, Behold, I make all things new. And he said unto me, Write: for these words are true and faithful. (You can count on what God says. His Word never changes)

⁶And he said unto me, It is done. I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end. I will give unto him that is athirst of the

fountain of the water of life freely. (This is the living water that Jesus spoke of to the woman at Jacob's well) see John-4:4-42

⁷ He that overcometh shall inherit all things; and I will be his God, and he shall be my son. (There are no genders in the Third Age. There is no need for male and female. We will all be one people, under God's rule)

⁸ But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death. Mathew-10:28 (The second death is the death of the soul – they no longer exist. The word hell should be translated the grave)

(Sorcerers = farmacia<Greek> = illegal drug dealers & drug pushers, and drug producers)

NOTE: (This also includes corrupt drug companies and their executives. They create drugs that don't cure the disease. These drugs only treat the symptoms; so that the sick people have to take their medicine for the rest of their lives. They do it to make far more profit than they would have made by curing the disease)

⁹ And there came unto me one of the seven angels which had the seven vials full of the seven last plagues, and talked with me, saying, Come hither, I will shew thee the bride, the Lamb's wife.

(The bride of Christ is the people who make the resurrection after the Millennium. They will have achieved immortality)

(The wife of Christ is the people who made it in the First Age. They are the Elect who stood with God against Satan at his rebellion <the Katabole>. They also testified for God before the whole world; when they were brought before antichrist, at the end of this Age) Romans-8

¹⁰ And he carried me away in the spirit to a great and high mountain, and shewed me that great city, the holy Jerusalem, descending out of heaven from God,

¹¹ Having the glory of God: and her light was like unto a stone most precious, even like a jasper stone, clear as crystal; (Pure and holy)

¹² And had a wall great and high, and had twelve gates, and at the gates twelve angels, and names written thereon, which are the names of the twelve tribes of the children of Israel:

¹³ On the east three gates; on the north three gates; on the south three gates; and on the west three gates. (These gates are laid out the same way that the twelve tribes camped around the tabernacle; when Moses led them through the wilderness)

¹⁴ And the wall of the city had twelve foundations, and in them the names of the twelve apostles of the Lamb. (Judas repented after he betrayed Jesus. He may very well be reinstated as an apostle of Jesus in the Third Age)

(Judas didn't commit suicide. The Kenites murdered him to keep him from talking about what they had done to Jesus) see Acts-1:18

NOTE: (We're not supposed to judge others. God is the judge. We will see at that time if Judas is one of the twelve)

¹⁵ And he that talked with me had a golden reed to measure the city, and the gates thereof, and the wall thereof. (This is not the measuring reed of Chapter-11; which was there for destruction. This measuring reed is there to bring peace, order and discipline to all people equally)

¹⁶ And the city lieth foursquare, and the length is as large as the breadth: and he measured the city with the reed, twelve thousand furlongs. The length and the breadth and the height of it are equal. (This city is a cube, about 1,500 miles per side)

¹⁷ And he measured the wall thereof, an hundred and forty and four cubits, according to the measure of a man, that is, of the angel.

¹⁸ And the building of the wall of it was of jasper: and the city was pure gold, like unto clear glass. (These are terms for purity – without defects)

¹⁹ And the foundations of the wall of the city were garnished with all manner of precious stones. The first foundation was jasper; the second, sapphire; the third, a chalcedony; the fourth, an emerald;

²⁰ The fifth, sardonyx; the sixth, sardius; the seventh, chrysolyte; the eighth, beryl; the ninth, a topaz; the tenth, a chrysoprasus; the eleventh, a jacinth; the twelfth, an amethyst.

²¹ And the twelve gates were twelve pearls: every several gate was of one pearl: and the street of the city was pure gold, as it were transparent glass.

²² And I saw no temple therein: for the Lord God Almighty and the Lamb are the temple of it. (With God's presence – we don't need a temple building)

(Jesus is God in the flesh. There is One God; He has many offices. Jesus said – If you've seen me, you've seen the Father) John-14:9, Isaiah-7:14

²³ And the city had no need of the sun, neither of the moon, to shine in it: for the glory of God did lighten it, and the Lamb is the light thereof. See Genesis-1:3 (Jesus is the light of the world)

²⁴ And the nations of them which are saved shall walk in the light of it: and the kings of the earth do bring their glory and honour into it. (the kings of the earth = the nations = the ethnos - the ethnic peoples – all the races)

(Heaven is for all the people; all the races; not just the 12 tribes of Israel)

Isaiah-60:11-22 (This is a second witness for Revelation-21 – written in approx. 600 BC. God's Word never changes. We can count on it)

²⁵ And the gates of it shall not be shut at all by day: for there shall be no night there. (There are no enemies left. There is no danger left. There is no need to shut the gates)

²⁶ And they shall bring the glory and honour of the nations into it. (nations = the ethnos – all ethnic peoples; the Gentiles. God has no favorites. HE treats everyone equally)

²⁷ And there shall in no wise enter into it any thing that defileth, neither whatsoever worketh abomination, or maketh a lie: but they which are written in the Lamb's book of life. (All evil is dead. Only the good people will be there; and God will rule justly over them all)
