

2 Timothy 2

King James Version (KJV)

2 Thou therefore, my son, be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus. (my spiritual son)

²And the things that thou hast heard of me among many witnesses, the same commit thou to faithful men, who shall be able to teach others also. (Pass the Word of God to others who are strong enough to teach correctly and boldly)

³Thou therefore endure hardness, as a good soldier of Jesus Christ. (The liberals hate Christians; always have and always will. Fight back against their evil. They are cowards who preach political correctness)

⁴No man that warreth entangleth himself with the affairs of this life; that he may please him who hath chosen him to be a soldier. (Don't let affairs of the world distract you in your fight against Satan. Satan is afraid of God)

⁵And if a man also strive for masteries, yet is he not crowned, except he strive lawfully. (masteries = Athletic; be physically fit; and more importantly, mentally and spiritually fit and prepared. Antichrist is coming to fight against Christianity by subverting it; in order to deceive the people. It's going to be a spiritual war and we need to be prepared)

(Also, always live within the law. Do things legally and you will be allowed to teach God's Word without government interference. Live by God's laws and you will live a healthy happy life with peace of mind)

⁶The husbandman that laboreth must be first partaker of the fruits. (God blesses His laborers. HE rewards us generously for our good works)

⁷Consider what I say; and the Lord give thee understanding in all things. (Meditate; let God's Holy Spirit give you wisdom in understanding the scriptures. Ask Him and He will help you) see Isaiah-43:26

⁸Remember that Jesus Christ of the seed of David was raised from the dead according to my gospel: (Jesus' victory over death, physical and spiritual, is the essence of the New Testament. God came into the world in the flesh, as Jesus, to defeat death and give salvation to all who believe on Him and repent) Hebrews-2:14

Psalms-22 & 23 (Prophesied the crucifixion and resurrection of Jesus Christ 1000 years before the fact. All of God's prophecies come true. Christianity is not just a religion. It is reality)

⁹Wherein I suffer trouble, as an evil doer, even unto bonds; but the word of God is not bound. (Paul suffered at the hand of the Kenites because he taught the Word of God. The Kenites wanted him dead. So did the Jews who refused Jesus; and stuck to the old statutes and ordinances of Moses)

(Yet through all of that, they couldn't stop him from spreading Christianity to so many people. Paul became one of the most successful Bible teachers of all time, with God's blessings)

¹⁰Therefore I endure all things for the elect's sakes, that they may also obtain the salvation which is in Christ Jesus with eternal glory. (The Word of God must be documented and passed down from generation to generation, until the end of this Age)

(At that time, the Elect, who will have been taught, will stand against antichrist and testify before the whole world) Mark-13, Matthew-24

¹¹It is a faithful saying: For if we be dead with him, we shall also live with him: (Resurrection into immortality for the eternity – the Third Age)

¹²If we suffer, we shall also reign with him: if we deny him, he also will deny us: Luke-12:8-12 (If the Elect deny Christ, HE will deny them. That is the only unforgivable sin. The Elect know the truth. They're not innocent. If they side with antichrist, against Jesus Christ; that would be an act of treason against God)

¹³If we believe not, yet he abideth faithful: he cannot deny himself.
(God wants all people to come to repentance. HE is always faithful to us. Upon repentance, we are forgiven)

Hebrews-13:5 (God will never leave us or forsake us. His loyalty never falters, even when ours does. We can take great comfort in that)

¹⁴Of these things put them in remembrance, charging them before the Lord that they strive not about words to no profit, but to the subverting of the hearers. (Don't waste your time arguing with Bible lawyers and false preachers. They twist words to deny Jesus. Focus on teaching the people the true Word of God – chapter by chapter, verse by verse)

¹⁵Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth. (Study God's Word, unchanged and complete. Understand the context in which each verse was written. Stay away from the traditions of men)

¹⁶But shun profane and vain babblings: for they will increase unto more ungodliness. (Most preachers today have no idea what they are teaching. They even celebrate Easter, amongst other things)

¹⁷And their word will eat as doth a canker: of whom is Hymenaeus and Philetus; (canker = gangrene – better translation)

(These two were false teachers who didn't believe that Jesus was God with us. Knowing that Jesus was God with us is the very foundation of Christianity) see Isaiah-7:14

NOTE: (God didn't send His "son" to be crucified. He begat Himself into flesh form, through Mary's womb. God never asked us to do something that He wouldn't do Himself. We pass through the flesh and so did He. Only, He lived a perfect life. We don't; but we are forgiven if we repent for our sins)

(Jesus said – If you've seen Me, you've seen the Father) see John-14:7-11

¹⁸Who concerning the truth have erred, saying that the resurrection is past already; and overthrow the faith of some. (Bad teachers drive

people away from God. People instinctively know when they are being lied to)

¹⁹ Nevertheless the foundation of God standeth sure, having this seal, The Lord knoweth them that are his. And, let every one that nameth the name of Christ depart from iniquity. (These are the Christians <Christ men and women>)

(The seven seals in revelation are about knowledge and wisdom. Let the Holy Spirit seal God's Word in your mind, and you will be ready when antichrist arrives. Fore warned is fore armed)

Deuteronomy 32:31-33 (Their rock is not our Rock. The Kenites' rock <Satan> is not our Rock <Jesus Christ>)

(Jesus Christ's teachings are our spiritual foundation)

²⁰ But in a great house there are not only vessels of gold and of silver, but also of wood and of earth; and some to honour, and some to dishonour. (Vessels represent the deeds that people do. We all have duties to do for the brotherhood of Christianity. Gold and silver represent our good works. Wood and earth degrade over time. They represent evil works)

²¹ If a man therefore purge himself from these, he shall be a vessel unto honour, sanctified, and meet for the master's use, and prepared unto every good work. (Separate yourself from the false preachers that babble and teach traditions of men. They are hell bound unless they repent)

²² Flee also youthful lusts: but follow righteousness, faith, charity, peace, with them that call on the Lord out of a pure heart. (Stay away from the impulsive ways of the world. Analyze what a preacher says to see if his teachings line up with God's Word. If they don't, then get rid of him. He is a fake)

²³ But foolish and unlearned questions avoid, knowing that they do gender strifes. (avoid argument; avoid the foolish; stay in God's Word)

(Jesus didn't argue with Satan in the wilderness. HE told Satan to get lost) Matthew-4:1-11

²⁴ And the servant of the Lord must not strive; but be gentle unto all men, apt to teach, patient, (No egoists should teach. You teach in order to help others, not to elevate yourself)

²⁵ In meekness instructing those that oppose themselves; if God peradventure will give them repentance to the acknowledging of the truth; (Humbly plant a seed of truth. If it grows, or if it doesn't; that will be up to God)

²⁶ And that they may recover themselves out of the snare of the devil, who are taken captive by him at his will. (If they learn from it, they might free themselves from the ways of the world and from the ways of Satan)
