Galatians 4

King James Version (KJV)

- **4** Now I say, That the heir, as long as he is a child, differeth nothing from a servant, though he be lord of all; (As a child, until you come to maturity, you will be subject to an adult parent, guardian, teacher, etc)
- ² But is under tutors and governors until the time appointed of the father.
- ³ Even so we, when we were children, were in bondage under the elements of the world: (As children, we were taught in the ways of the world)
- ⁴But when the fulness of the time was come, God sent forth his Son, made of a woman, made under the law, (His begotten- not His "son"; Jesus is Immanuel God with us) see Isaiah-7:14

NOTE: (God never asked us to do something that He wouldn't do Himself. Let us create man in OUR image. We created our flesh bodies; He created the Office of Jesus – God in the flesh. We all pass through the flesh just once – to be tested) Genesis-1:26-28

- ⁵To redeem them that were under the law, that we might receive the adoption of sons. (Christians become the adopted children of God because we accept Jesus as God with us)
- ⁶ And because ye are sons, God hath sent forth the Spirit of his Son into your hearts, crying, Abba, Father. (God's Holy Spirit is with us today to give us comfort and strength)

NOTE: (There is only one God. HE has many offices – The Father, Jesus, the Holy Spirit, Immanuel, Melchizedek, the Angel of God, etc)

- Wherefore thou art no more a servant, but a son; and if a son, then an heir of God through Christ. (Christians will inherit eternal life with God in the Third Age the eternity)
- ⁸ Howbeit then, when ye knew not God, ye did service unto them which by nature are no gods. (Before they learned God's Word, they served the ways of the world)

- But now, after that ye have known God, or rather are known of God, how turn ye again to the weak and beggarly elements, whereunto ye desire again to be in bondage? (Why are you going back to the ways of the world after you learned of the New Testament and salvation? Why go back into bondage after you have been freed?)
- ¹⁰ Ye observe days, and months, and times, and years. (You have reverted back to the old ordinances and statutes; and abandoned the salvation that Jesus gave us. You are worshipping days and months, instead of Jesus Christ, who became our Sabbath everyday)

(Sabbath = rest, peace of mind)

- 1Corinthinans-5:6-7 (Christ became our Passover)
- ¹¹ I am afraid of you, lest I have bestowed upon you labour in vain. (I am afraid for you. Did I teach you God's Word in vain?)
- ¹² Brethren, I beseech you, be as I am; for I am as ye are: ye have not injured me at all. (Come back to salvation, and rejoin the Christian family. You're only harming yourself if you don't return to Christ)
- ¹³ Ye know how <u>through infirmity of the flesh</u> I preached the gospel unto you at the first. (through infirmity of the flesh = through weakness, temptations, fatigue, hunger, other doubts of the flesh; like Paul's poor vision, or the people who wanted him dead, etc...)
- ¹⁴ And my temptation which was in my flesh ye despised not, nor rejected; but received me as an angel of God, even as Christ Jesus. (They had accepted Paul as a Bible teacher, and learned God's Word from him; even though they knew of his past offences of persecuting Christians)
- ¹⁵ Where is then the blessedness ye spake of? for I bear you record, that, if it had been possible, ye would have plucked out your own eyes, and have given them to me. (They were so grateful to Paul for having taught them, that they would have donated their own eyes to him if they could have. So, why have they now changed their minds?)
- ¹⁶ Am I therefore become your enemy, because I tell you the truth? (Do you prefer to hear men's doctrines, rather than the truth?)
- ¹⁷They zealously affect you, but not well; yea, they would exclude you, that ye might affect them. (They tell you what you want to hear, and

then pump you up with excitement. Yet they are not in it to bring you salvation. They are in it for their ego and for your money. They sure put on a good show)

- ¹⁸ But it is good to be zealously affected always in a good thing, and not only when I am present with you. (If you're going to be zealous, make sure that it is over a true teaching)
- ¹⁹ My little children, of whom I travail in <u>birth again</u> until Christ be formed in you, (This is where the "born agains" get their doctrine. Paul was talking about figuratively and spiritually born into Christianity)

(There is no "New Christianity". The one that Jesus taught us is the only Christianity, once and for all time. It comprises of both the Old and the New Testaments)

²⁰ I desire to be present with you now, and to change my voice; for I stand in doubt of you. (Paul was sorry that he could not able to be there in person; because he doubted their sincerity in wanting to follow Jesus' teachings)

(They wanted to revert to the old ways of circumcision and animal sacrifices. That would be an insult to God. Jesus paid the price on the cross, for all time for our salvation)

- ²¹ Tell me, ye that desire to be under the law, do ye not hear the law? (Have you even studied the law in God's Word? Do you know the difference between the law, civil statutes and the blood ordinances? Or, do you just listen to smooth talking false preachers?)
- ²² For it is written, that Abraham had two sons, the one by a bondmaid, the other by a freewoman.

(Isaac <by Sarah – an Israelite> – who was in Jesus' bloodline and fathered Jacob – the patriarch of the 12 tribes of Israel)

(and Ishmael <by Hagar – a Egyptian concubine > – who became head of the Arabic peoples. They later founded the Muslim cult through Mohammad)

²³ But he who was of the bondwoman was born after the flesh; but he of the freewoman was by promise. (God promised Abraham a son through Sarah <Isaac>)

(Sarah doubted God, because of her old age. She coerced Abraham to have a baby with Hagar, her maid <Ishmael>)

²⁴ Which things are an allegory: for these are the two covenants; the one from the mount Sinai, which gendereth to bondage, which is Agar. (Christianity is <freedom> thorough Jesus; Islam is <bondage and slavery to a false god <Allah>)

²⁵ For this <u>Agar is mount Sinai in Arabia</u>, and answereth to Jerusalem which now is, and is in bondage with her children. (Because the Jews refused Jesus Christ as the Messiah)

(In the Arabian tongue, Hagar and Sinai both mean rock. Their rock is not our Rock. Our Rock is Jesus Christ) Deuteronomy-32

(Isaac, through Jesus brought us Christianity; Ishmael, through Mohammad, brought us the cult of Islam)

²⁶ But Jerusalem which is above is free, which is the mother of us all. (Christianity – the truth will set you free) John 8:31-55, Isaiah-7:14

²⁷ For it is written, Rejoice, thou <u>barren</u> that bearest not; break forth and cry, thou that travailest not: for the desolate hath many more children than she which hath an husband. (Antichrist will deceive the whole world in the end days. They will think that he is Jesus, returned. They will be spiritually impregnated with his false doctrine)

Paul is quoting Isaiah-54:1 (In the end days, the "barren" will not be seduced by antichrist, when he arrives at the 6th Trump, to deceive the whole world. They will still be spiritual virgins when Jesus returns at the 7th Trump, because they waited for Him) also see Luke-23:28-31

²⁸ Now we, brethren, as Isaac was, are the children of promise. (The promise of salvation through Jesus Christ)

²⁹ But as then he that was born after the flesh persecuted him that was born after the Spirit, even so it is now. (Prophesy for Islam?)

NOTE: (Today, Muslims live to persecute and kill Christians and Jews all over the world. Their doctrine is – Join us or die. Satan couldn't have said it better. Islam's so called prophet <Mohammad> was a thief, a murderer and a rapist. It's well documented in history)

³⁰ Nevertheless what saith the scripture? Cast out the bondwoman and her son: for the son of the bondwoman shall not be heir with the son of the freewoman. (Don't believe the inclusiveness of political correctness. There is no one religion that includes all beliefs. Islam has no place in God's Word) John-8:12-30

³¹ So then, brethren, we are not children of the bondwoman, but of the free. (The truth of God's Word is absolute. You either believe it or you don't. We are the children of God through our belief in Christianity)

John-8:32 (Jesus said – Ye shall know the truth and the truth will set you free)
