John 17

King James Version (KJV)

(This is Jesus' prayer to the Father)

17 These words spake Jesus, and lifted up his eyes to heaven, and said, Father, the hour is come; glorify thy Son, that thy Son also may glorify thee: (Jesus was as human as we are. HE knew that He was about to be murdered. His ministry was coming to an end. Jesus will be glorified when He resurrects from the dead. His glorification is also the Father's glorification. They are one and the same God in two different forms)

NOTE: (Jesus prayed to the Father to teach us by example. When you see trouble coming your way, pray to the Father for help. HE will always hear you)

- ² As thou hast given him power over all flesh, that he should give eternal life to as many as thou hast given him. (God chose the Elect in the First Age because they stood with Him against Satan. He used them in this Age to serve as prophets, in the Old Testament. And now as servants to advance Christ's church, Christianity, in the New Testament)
- ³ And this is life eternal, that they might know thee the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom thou hast sent. (There is only one God, and Jesus is that God, sent to us in the flesh form of a man)
- ⁴I have glorified thee on the earth: I have finished the work which thou gavest me to do. (Jesus came to us with a mission of opening salvation to all people who believe on Him)

(When Satan engineers His murder, Jesus will also have destroyed the devil, with a death sentence. That death sentence will be carried out just before the Third Age begins) Hebrews-2:13-14

- ⁵ And now, O Father, glorify thou me with thine own self with the glory which I had with thee before the world was. (Jesus is the Living Word. HE is God, in the form of a man) John-1:1-5
- I have manifested thy name unto the men which thou gavest me out of the world: thine they were, and thou gavest them me; and they have kept thy word. (These are the Elect)

(YHVH - Yahoveh - God's Name; Yeshuah = Joshua = Jesus = Yahoveh's Savior; Christian = Christ's man)

(God gave these Elect <the apostles> to Jesus. They were there to continue Jesus' ministry throughout the world)

- Now they have known that all things whatsoever thou hast given me are of thee. (These Elect have learned from Jesus)
- *For I have given unto them the words which thou gavest me; and they have received them, and have known surely that I came out from thee, and they have believed that thou didst send me. (The Apostles walked with Jesus. They learned God's Word directly from Him. After Jesus ascended into Heaven, they were led by God's Holy Spirit to continue His work. Jesus knew them because He was the living Word God in the flesh)

(Even the Pharisees and the Sadducees were amazed at Jesus' knowledge of the scriptures. That didn't stop them from committing His murder; because they are of the devil)

(To believe that Jesus is God with us is to obtain salvation) John-1:1, Genesis-1:26

- ⁹I pray for them: I pray not for the world, but for them which thou hast given me; for they are thine. Ephesians-1:4
- ¹⁰ And all mine are thine, and thine are mine; and I am glorified in them. (To be a good Christian is to glorify God; as the Father, the creator; and as Jesus, the Savior)
- ¹¹ And now I am no more in the world, but these are in the world, and I come to thee. Holy Father, keep through thine own name those whom thou hast given me, that they may be one, as we are. (The Elect will continue the work that Jesus started. They will need God's blessings in order to succeed in this evil world)
- ¹² While I was with them in the world, I kept them in thy name: those that thou gavest me I have kept, and none of them is lost, <u>but the son of perdition</u>; that the scripture might be fulfilled. (The son of perdition is Satan. When he caused Jesus to be crucified, Satan signed his own death warrant. There is no more chance for salvation for him. He is a dead man, walking) see Ezekiel-28:18-19, Genesis-3:15

NOTES: (When Satan rebelled against God in the First Age, he drew in 1/3 of all souls to follow him and worship him. These are the Kenites today. Rather than destroy one third of His children, God ended the Age) Revelation-12

(We all pas through this Second Age, innocent, in order to choose – do we follow God, or do we follow the ways of Satan and of this world. That is why we are here. That is the "meaning of life" that philosophers try to understand. They don't realize that it is all written for us in the Bible)

- ¹³ And now come I to thee; and these things I speak in the world, that they might have my joy fulfilled in themselves. (Jesus returning to the Father was good news for all mankind. HE opened salvation to all of us, if we choose it) (Gospel = good news)
- ¹⁴I have given them thy word; and the world hath hated them, because they are not of the world, even as I am not of the world. (To follow Jesus Christ is to be hated by the world <Satan, the Kenites, Atheists, Muslims and everyone else who persecutes Christianity>)

(Christians are not of this world because we follow the ways of God)

- ¹⁵ I pray not that thou shouldest take them out of the world, but that thou shouldest keep them from the evil. (Jesus prayed to God for our protection from the ways of the world)
- ¹⁶ They are not of the world, even as I am not of the world. (The Elect were chosen before the <u>foundation of the world</u> <EON, in the Greek>. They were chosen in the First Age) Ephesians-1:4, Jeremiah-1:5
- ¹⁷ <u>Sanctify</u> them through thy truth: thy word is truth. (Sanctify = set aside)

(Jesus said – You shall know the truth and the truth shall set you free) John-8:32

- ¹⁸ As thou hast sent me into the world, even so have I also sent them into the world. (Apostle = a sent one)
- ¹⁹ And for their sakes I sanctify myself, that they also might be sanctified through the truth.

- ²⁰ Neither pray I for these alone, but for them also which shall believe on me through their word; (We are sanctified by God in order to be able to help others to find salvation. Jesus prays for all those who hear the Word that they might believe and be saved)
- ²¹ That they all may be one; as thou, Father, art in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in us: that the world may believe that thou hast sent me. (Christians become a part of God's family)
- ²² And the glory which thou gavest me I have given them; that they may be one, <u>even as we are one</u>: Isaiah-7:14 (Jesus is God, in the flesh. Immanuel <Hebrew> means God with us)
- ²³ I in them, and thou in me, that they may be made perfect in one; and that the world may know that thou hast sent me, and hast loved them, as thou hast loved me. (God saves us because He loves us. But we have to choose Him in order to receive that salvation) Hosea-6:6
- ²⁴ Father, I will that they also, whom thou hast given me, be with me where I am; that they may behold my glory, which thou hast given me: for thou lovedst me before the <u>foundation of the world</u>. (foundation = Katabole Satans rebellion and his defeat in the First Age; world= Kosmos in the Greek manuscripts) John-1:1
- ²⁵ O righteous Father, the world hath not known thee: but I have known thee, and these have known that thou hast sent me. (Even today, many in the world continue to live in the darkness of ignorance and confusion. They think that they need to "get ahead" in the world, even at others' expense. Their money and power won't help them one bit on judgment day)
- ²⁶ And I have declared unto them thy name, and will declare it: that the love wherewith thou hast loved me may be in them, and I in them. (That's the presence of God's Holy Spirit. HE abides in all people that invite Him in <Christians>)
