

Matthew 10

King James Version (KJV)

10 And when he had called unto him his twelve disciples, he gave them power against unclean spirits, to cast them out, and to heal all manner of sickness and all manner of disease. (Power - in His name)
(God expects Christians to use His power against evil)

² Now the names of the twelve apostles are these; The first, Simon, who is called Peter, and Andrew his brother; James the son of Zebedee, and John his brother; (Apostles = sent ones; they were no longer disciples, which are students)

³ Philip, and Bartholomew; Thomas, and Matthew the publican; James the son of Alphaeus, and Lebbaeus, whose surname was Thaddaeus; (publican - a tax collector for the Roman Empire)

⁴ Simon the Canaanite, and Judas Iscariot, who also betrayed him. (the Canaanite = the zealot - bad translation from the manuscripts)

(Iscariot = builder of cities - he was probably a Kenite. God cursed Cain and his descendants <the Kenites> after he killed Abel. Kenites cannot farm, so they became builders of cities, lawyers, bankers, money lenders, merchants etc.) See Genesis-4:17

(The Kenites had infiltrated and bred into the families of the 12 tribes)
See Joshua-9:22, 1Chronicles-2:55, 2 Kings 10:15, Judges-4:11, Jeremiah-35:2-8

⁵ These twelve Jesus sent forth, and commanded them, saying, Go not into the way of the Gentiles, and into any city of the Samaritans enter ye not: (Salvation would later be open to everyone; after Jesus was crucified and resurrected)

⁶ But go rather to the lost sheep of the house of Israel. (To the 12 tribes only)

⁷ And as ye go, preach, saying, The kingdom of heaven is at hand. (Upon His crucifixion, Jesus would begin the New Covenant, or New Testament. The Kingdom of heaven is now open to all who believe in Jesus, as God in the flesh, and follow His Ten Commandments)

⁸ Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out devils: freely ye have received, freely give. (Salvation is free to all who choose it. It's not for sale by greedy preachers)

(Jesus paid the price for all of us when He was crucified. Don't let greedy, false preachers sell you "tickets to Heaven" and other "holy relics". These guys are nothing but con men)

⁹ Provide neither gold, nor silver, nor brass in your purses, (purses were used to collect money with. Jesus paid the price of salvation. It's not the preacher's to sell. Jesus never sent out beggars)

¹⁰ Nor scrip for your journey, neither two coats, neither shoes, nor yet staves: for the workman is worthy of his meat. (scrip = a begging bag) (Teachers are worthy of making an honest living. They are not worthy of becoming rich from tithes and from begging)

¹¹ And into whatsoever city or town ye shall enter, enquire who in it is worthy; and there abide till ye go thence. (Go into one house, and stay there for the duration of your visit to that town. Don't go from house to house. It was customary to have a feast on the first evening when a preacher arrived. Jesus didn't want them moving house to house – banquet to banquet. Their job was to teach God's Word; not to celebrate)

¹² And when ye come into an house, salute it. (Shalom – wish them peace in God's name)

¹³ And if the house be worthy, let your peace come upon it: but if it be not worthy, let your peace return to you. (If it's worthy of learning the truth, give them the truth. If not, then leave)

¹⁴ And whosoever shall not receive you, nor hear your words, when ye depart out of that house or city, shake off the dust of your feet. (Move on. Don't waste your time with people who don't want to learn)

¹⁵ Verily I say unto you, It shall be more tolerable for the land of Sodom and Gomorrah in the day of judgment, than for that city. (That's because Sodom & Gomorrah never heard the truth of God's Word. They were ignorant. These guys <the 12 tribes> did, and then chose to reject it. They were not innocent)

¹⁶ Behold, I send you forth as sheep in the midst of wolves: be ye therefore wise as serpents, and harmless as doves. (wise as = wiser than - better translation)

(The wolves are the people who are wise in the ways of the world; serpents are symbolic for the Kenites. The Shepherd <Jesus> is our protection against the wolves and serpents of the world)

¹⁷ But beware of men: for they will deliver you up to the councils, and they will scourge you in their synagogues; (The world has always hated and persecuted Christians. Even today in the US, we are mocked and ridiculed)

(This verse speaks to when antichrist is here, in the end days of this Age. The Elect will be delivered up to the synagogue of Satan to be persecuted. Instead, their testimony <from the Holy Spirit> will awaken people who were previously deceived by antichrist) see Matthew-24, Mark-13, and Luke-21

¹⁸ And ye shall be brought before governors and kings for my sake, for a testimony against them and the Gentiles. (For Christ's sake) (them - the Kenites; Gentiles = nations)

NOTE: (Look at the Muslims nations today - attacking and murdering Christians; burning down Christian churches, etc. Islam is the modern cult for Satan. It is hell bent on destroying Christianity. They will fail)

¹⁹ But when they deliver you up, take no thought how or what ye shall speak: for it shall be given you in that same hour what ye shall speak. (The hour of temptation – when Satan is here as antichrist)

²⁰ For it is not ye that speak, but the Spirit of your Father which speaketh in you. (They will speak in the cloven tongue - as foretold by Joel the prophet. Everyone will hear the message in their own native language, all at the same time. Man cannot do that. Only God can)

NOTE: (Jesus just explained who the Holy Spirit is. There is only one God. He has many offices. Preachers have changed this over the centuries to teach that there are three Gods existing together in a "holy trinity". This is false teaching. Jesus taught that He was God, in the flesh. Son should be translated "begotten". God became a flesh man <Jesus> through Mary)

²¹ And the brother shall deliver up the brother to death, and the father the child: and the children shall rise up against their parents, and cause them to be put to death. (Death is one of Satan's names. The deceived people will think that antichrist is Jesus; who has returned to rapture them away. They will deliver up their own family members to antichrist because they are trying to save them)

Hebrews-2:14 (Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, he also himself likewise took part of the same; that through death he might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil)

²² And ye shall be hated of all men for my name's sake: but he that endureth to the end shall be saved. (Those who are not fooled by antichrist will be hated. Today, Christians are already being attacked by the politically correct Christians, by the atheists, by the communists and by the Muslims)

²³ But when they persecute you in this city, flee ye into another: for verily I say unto you, Ye shall not have gone over the cities of Israel, till the Son of man be come. (Satan's time as antichrist was shortened from 3 1/2 years down to 5 months <the season of the locust>) See Matthew-24:22

²⁴ The disciple is not above his master, nor the servant above his lord. (Teach the Word, unchanged, and properly translated. You are not a prophet or some great visionary. You are a student. Teach humbly and honestly)

²⁵ It is enough for the disciple that he be as his master, and the servant as his lord. If they have called the master of the house Beelzebub, how much more shall they call them of his household? (They hated Jesus so much that they had Him murdered. They will hate those who follow Him just as much) see Mark-3:22

²⁶ Fear them not therefore: for there is nothing covered, that shall not be revealed; and hid, that shall not be known. (We know that God and His faithful followers will win in the end. Don't fear the wicked ways of the world. Don't fear those who follow the ways of the world)

(Moral correctness is far wiser than political correctness)

²⁷ What I tell you in darkness, that speak ye in light: and what ye hear in the ear, that preach ye upon the housetops. (What Jesus taught

privately; you teach it publicly; and don't change the teaching. Teach God's Word chapter by chapter, verse by verse)

²⁸ And fear not them which kill the body, but are not able to kill the soul: but rather fear him which is able to destroy both soul and body in hell. (Hell is not a place of punishment. It is the death of the soul. Those who "go to hell" are gone forever. They don't exist anymore)

Ezekiel-28:18-19 (Satan will die at the end of the Millennium. There is no real "hell" where souls burn; fire wouldn't hurt a soul anyway. The word hell should be translated - the grave)

²⁹ Are not two sparrows sold for a farthing? and one of them shall not fall on the ground without your Father. (God knows all creatures, down to a sparrow. HE cares about all of His creatures. We are far more valuable to Him than a sparrow)

³⁰ But the very hairs of your head are all numbered. (God cares about each one of us; right down to the number of hairs on our head)

³¹ Fear ye not therefore, ye are of more value than many sparrows. (God values every soul and whishes all would repent and have eternal life with Him – they won't)

NOTE: (People tend to fear or worry about the future. Stay in God's Word and live it; and you will have His love and protection no matter what the world brings on)

³² Whosoever therefore shall confess me before men, him will I confess also before my Father which is in heaven. (Be faithful to Jesus before the world and He will be faithful to you in Heaven. Jesus, being God in the flesh, is our advocate for how we conduct ourselves here in this life)

NOTE: (God never asked us to do anything He wouldn't do Himself. HE lived a perfect life on earth as Jesus. Therefore, He is qualified to be our advocate and our judge in the afterlife)

³³ But whosoever shall deny me before men, him will I also deny before my Father which is in heaven. (Evil people won't be able to say – "you don't know what it was like in the flesh. It was so bad..." God knows because He lived in the flesh life as Jesus. They persecuted and crucified Him. HE knows what the Kenites are capable of doing)

³⁴ Think not that I am come to send peace on earth: I came not to send peace, but a sword. (the sword is the Word of God, which proceeds out of His mouth. The truth is absolute. Therefore it divides people; some believe it, others don't. There is no in-between)
Revelation-1:16-17

NOTE: (Lies on the other hand, can be changed to include the good and the bad. Today, it is called intersectionality and inclusivity. It's all about political correctness instead of moral correctness. That is Satan's M.O.)

³⁵ For I am come to set a man at variance against his father, and the daughter against her mother, and the daughter in law against her mother in law. (The truth is the narrow path. If you change it in the least, it is no longer the truth)

(Satan as antichrist will turn people against each other; because many will think he is Jesus, returned. Others will see him for what he really is. That will be the conflict that is written in this verse)

³⁶ And a man's foes shall be they of his own household. (Some will believe God's Word, some won't. Some will be deceived by antichrist, some won't. That is what will divide families in the end days)

³⁷ He that loveth father or mother more than me is not worthy of me: and he that loveth son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me. (God must come first in our lives. People can inadvertently draw us down the wrong path, if we let them. Stay true to God's Word and you will be OK)

Luke-14:26 (This verse was mistranslated in the English. You must love God more than your parents. Ignorant preachers think it means you must hate your parents and siblings. The verse should have been translated "love less", not "hate")

³⁸ And he that taketh not his cross, and followeth after me, is not worthy of me. (True followers of God will be persecuted in the world - by the atheists, the Muslims and the politically correct. Don't be intimidated by the ignorant masses)

³⁹ He that findeth his life shall lose it: and he that loseth his life for my sake shall find it. (his life = himself, his soul - better translation)

(If you choose service to God over selfishness in the world, you will have eternal life in Heaven. If you choose a selfish comfortable life in the world over service to God, you will lose your eternal life in Heaven)

⁴⁰ He that receiveth you receiveth me, and he that receiveth me receiveth him that sent me. (Genesis – Let us make man in our image – we are our image, in the flesh; Jesus is God's image in the flesh. Receive Him and you are receiving God)

See Isaiah-7:14 (Immanuel = God with us; God in th flesh)

⁴¹ He that receiveth a prophet in the name of a prophet shall receive a prophet's reward; and he that receiveth a righteous man in the name of a righteous man shall receive a righteous man's reward. (All of the prophets are written in the Bible – Old and New Testaments)

(Beware of a modern day preacher who is claiming to be a prophet. He's a fake)

⁴² And whosoever shall give to drink unto one of these little ones a cup of cold water only in the name of a disciple, verily I say unto you, he shall in no wise lose his reward. (The drink of water is the Living Water – the Word of God)

(After you learn God's Word, share it with others who want to learn. Don't keep it to yourself)
