John 14

King James Version (KJV)

- **14** Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God, believe also in me. (The last verse in the previous chapter Jesus just told Peter that he would deny knowing Him three times)
- ²In my Father's house are many <u>mansions</u>: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. (mansion = Mone<Greek>; Mansion = a resting place better translation)

NOTE: (These aren't mansions like we see today. In the spiritual body, we don't need a house. Our rest is in Jesus Christ. We have it every day if we choose it. It is peace of mind and receiving His blessings)

- ³ And if I go and prepare a place for you, <u>I will come again</u>, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also. (Jesus will return at the Second Advent as Lord of lords, King of kings. That will happen at the 7th Trump, at the end of this Age)
- ⁴And whither I go ye know, and the way ye know. Ecclesiastes-12:6-7, Psalms-22, Isaiah-7:14
- ⁵Thomas saith unto him, Lord, we know not whither thou goest; and how can we know the way? (Jesus taught them over and over that He is the way. HE is the way to salvation. His teachings are the way to salvation)
- ⁶Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me. (Christianity is the only way to salvation and to eternal life with God. Only He can forgive our sins and give us salvation)
- 'If ye had known me, ye should have known my Father also: and <u>from henceforth ye know him, and have seen him</u>. (Jesus is one of God's offices. HE is God, in the flesh. God has many offices, but there is only one God. These apostles have been walking with God)

NOTES: (The trinity was invented by the early church. It is traditions of men that lead people astray. I have heard Christians say – "What kind of God would send His own Son to be crucified?" That is ignorance)

(The Muslims say that Christians are polytheists, because of the church's trinity teaching. That is wrong. True Christianity teaches us that there is only one God. He has many offices. HE can present Himself to us in any form, at any time that He chooses)

- 8 Philip saith unto him, Lord, show us the Father, and it sufficeth us.
- ⁹Jesus saith unto him, Have I been so long time with you, and yet hast thou not known me, Philip? <u>he that hath seen me hath seen the Father</u>; and how sayest thou then, Show us the Father?

Isaiah-7:14 (Jesus is God in the flesh. Not His "son" but rather His begotten. God came to us as a flesh man, through Mary. HE came to be crucified to end Satan. By crucifying Jesus, Satan signed his own death sentence)

NOTE: (You either believe it or you don't. There is no in-between. In Genesis-1:26, God made Jesus in His image and we made our flesh bodies in our image. When our flesh body dies, we return to our spiritual body)

- ¹⁰ Believest thou not that I am in the Father, and the Father in me? the words that I speak unto you I speak not of myself: but the Father that <u>dwelleth</u> in me, he doeth the works. (dwelleth this is from the same prime as mansion <in the Greek>. It means together. It means to be at rest with)
- ¹¹ Believe me that I am in the Father, and the Father in me: or else believe me for the very works' sake. (The many miracles that Jesus performed in their sight should have been proof. Only God has the power over life and death. Jesus is God, in the form of a man)

NOTE: (The prophets who performed miracles asked God; and He made it so. Jesus ordered Lazarus to get up. HE ordered the infirm to get up and walk. HE wasn't just a prophet. HE was God in the flesh)

¹² Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father. (Today, with communications technology, we can instantly easily reach the whole world with the Word of God. That is what Jesus was referring to in this verse)

(In the end days of this Age, the Elect will testify against antichrist. Theyi testimony will be broadcast before the whole world. That would

not have been possible in the days of Jesus, because the technology to do that didn't exist yet)

¹³ And whatsoever <u>ye shall ask in my name</u>, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. (When we are doing God's works, He will provide what we need)

(By being good Christians < Christ's men>, we glorify God)

- ¹⁴ If ye shall ask any thing in my name, I will do it. (When we are doing God's work)
- ¹⁵ If ye love me, keep my commandments. (All Ten Commandments)

NOTE: (This is another witness that Jesus didn't do away with the Law <the Ten Commandments>, as some ignorant preachers teach)

- ¹⁶ And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever; (The Holy Spirit of God; this is another one of God's many offices. HE is God, in spirit form)
- ¹⁷ Even the Spirit of truth; whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth him not, neither knoweth him: but ye know him; for <u>he dwelleth with you, and shall be in you</u>. (The ways of the world are contrary to the ways of God. That's why the world cannot see God's Spirit)
- ¹⁸ I will not leave you comfortless: <u>I will come to you</u>. (He did come to us as the Holy Spirit. Jesus is God, just like is His Holy Spirit. One God, many offices)
- ¹⁹ Yet a little while, and the world seeth me no more; but ye see me: because I live, ye shall live also. (The unbelieving world won't see God after Jesus ascends into Heaven. If we believe, God will give us eternal life in the Third Age)
- ²⁰ At that day ye shall know that I am in my Father, and ye in me, and I in you. (We are one family in God)
- ²¹ He that hath my commandments, <u>and keepeth them</u>, he it is that loveth me: and he that loveth me shall be loved of my Father, and I will love him, and will manifest myself to him. (Knowing the commandments isn't enough; you have to do them)

- ²² Judas saith unto him, not Iscariot, Lord, how is it that thou wilt manifest thyself unto us, and not unto the world? (They still don't get it)
- ²³ Jesus answered and said unto him, If a man love me, he will keep my words: and my Father will love him, and we will come unto him, and make our <u>abode</u> with him. (abode this is the same word as mansion <in the Greek manuscripts>) see Psalms-91:1-16
- ²⁴ He that loveth me not keepeth not my sayings: and the word which ye hear is not mine, but the Father's which sent me.
- John-1:1 (In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God)
- ²⁵ These things have I spoken unto you, being yet present with you.
- ²⁶ But the Comforter, which is the <u>Holy Ghost</u>, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you. (Holy Ghost = Holy Spirit = Neuma < Greek> this is a bad translation; God is not a spook. HE has a spirit just like we do)
- ²⁷ Peace I leave with you, my peace I give unto you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid. (Christ brings peace of mind and spiritual comfort)
- ²⁸ Ye have heard how I said unto you, I go away, and come again unto you. If ye loved me, ye would rejoice, because I said, I go unto the Father: for my Father is greater than I. (Jesus is God, but He is in the flesh. Our flesh bodies also limit our abilities. The Father is God in His true form. Our spiritual bodies are us in our true form. We are very old, but spiritual bodies do not age or get sick)
- ²⁹ And now I have told you before it come to pass, that, when it is come to pass, ye might believe. (Seeing prophecy come to pass builds and reinforces our faith in God)
- ³⁰ Hereafter I will not talk much with you: for the prince of this world cometh, and hath nothing in me. (That is Satan)
- ³¹ But that the world may know that I love the Father; and as the Father gave me commandment, even so I do. Arise, let us go hence. Hebrews-2:14-15 (Jesus came into this world as a flesh man to defeat

death; which is one of the devil's names. Jesus continued to do good works until His ascension into Heaven)

NOTE: (When Satan had Jesus crucified by the Romans, he signed his own death warrant for murder. That's why Jesus allowed it. Satan started the conflict; and God will finish it, permanently) Genesis-3:15
