

Ezekiel 8

King James Version (KJV)

8 And it came to pass in the sixth year, in the sixth month, in the fifth day of the month, as I sat in mine house, and the elders of Judah sat before me, that the hand of the Lord God fell there upon me. (The elders of Jerusalem came to Ezekiel's house for advice)

(Their nation was falling apart and they were seeking advice. Did they listen to what he told them?)

²Then I beheld, and lo a likeness as the appearance of fire: from the appearance of his loins even downward, fire; and from his loins even upward, as the appearance of brightness, as the colour of amber. (God appeared to Ezekiel)

³And he put forth the form of an hand, and took me by a lock of mine head; and the spirit lifted me up between the earth and the heaven, and brought me in the visions of God to Jerusalem, to the door of the inner gate that looketh toward the north; where was the seat of the image of jealousy, which provoketh to jealousy. (God put Ezekiel into a trance so that He could teach him how to respond to the elders of Judah)

Isaiah-14 (God's throne will be set up on the north side at the 7th Trump. That will be the judgment seat)

(Satan knows that. He is jealous of Jesus as Messiah. So that is where he will also set up his throne; on the north side, when he comes as antichrist at the 6th Trump)

⁴And, behold, the glory of the God of Israel was there, according to the vision that I saw in the plain. (This will happen at the Third Age)

⁵Then said he unto me, Son of man, lift up thine eyes now the way toward the north. So I lifted up mine eyes the way toward the north, and behold northward at the gate of the altar this image of jealousy in the entry. (Satan will be there; pretending to be Jesus. People will be swooning before him and worshipping him as if he was God. This is an insult to God, who created us and gave us everything)

⁶He said furthermore unto me, Son of man, seest thou what they do? even the great abominations that the house of Israel committeth here,

that I should go far off from my sanctuary? but turn thee yet again, and thou shalt see greater abominations. (God is disgusted with us)

⁷ And he brought me to the door of the court; and when I looked, behold a hole in the wall. (The court is where judgment takes place)

⁸ Then said he unto me, Son of man, dig now in the wall: and when I had digged in the wall, behold a door. (Something covered or hidden was going on behind the door)

⁹ And he said unto me, Go in, and behold the wicked abominations that they do here. (They had completely perverted worship and judgment. They abandoned God and brought in heathen idols to worship. They twisted the laws to benefit themselves)

¹⁰ So I went in and saw; and behold every form of creeping things, and abominable beasts, and all the idols of the house of Israel, pourtrayed upon the wall round about. (There was false teachings and traditions of men, in the House of God; such as - Eve eating an apple, Easter replacing Passover, who the Kenites are, homosexuality as a lifestyle, pedophilia, human sacrifice to false deities and other perversions, political correctness replacing morality)

¹¹ And there stood before them seventy men of the ancients of the house of Israel, and in the midst of them stood Jaazaniah the son of Shaphan, with every man his censer in his hand; and a thick cloud of incense went up. (Jaazaniah = heard of Yah; Shaphan = conies or rabbits, like an Easter bunny; each had a censer in his hand - these guys are priests, who are not teaching the true Word of God)

(They are teaching heathen worship; but they sure know how to make it all look so holy – with the incense)

¹² Then said he unto me, Son of man, hast thou seen what the ancients of the house of Israel do in the dark, every man in the chambers of his imagery? for they say, the LORD seeth us not; the LORD hath forsaken the earth. (They think God doesn't see what they are doing. Many even admit that they don't believe in God)

¹³ He said also unto me, Turn thee yet again, and thou shalt see greater abominations that they do.

¹⁴ Then he brought me to the door of the gate of the LORD's house which was toward the north; and, behold, there sat women weeping

for Tammuz. (Tammuz = sprout of life – a heathen goddess over animals, agricultural life and obscene rites. She was worshipped along with Ishtar the goddess of heaven and of fertility – right in God's temple)

(Today, Christians still celebrate Easter <a pagan holiday ritual to the pagan goddess Ishtar>. They have replaced Passover with – the Easter bunny, rolling Easter eggs of fertility, sunrise services, etc. This is an abomination to God. God told us to celebrate Passover, not Easter)

See Acts-12:4 (The Bible translators even mistranslated the Greek word Pasca <Passover> to the English word Easter <Ishtar>)

1Corinthians-5:6-7 (Christ became our Passover)

¹⁵Then said he unto me, Hast thou seen this, O son of man? turn thee yet again, and thou shalt see greater abominations than these. (How can it get any worse?)

¹⁶And he brought me into the inner court of the LORD's house, and, behold, at the door of the temple of the LORD, between the porch and the altar, were about five and twenty men, with their backs toward the temple of the LORD, and their faces toward the east; and they worshipped the sun toward the east. 2Kings-23:5-10 (There were sun worshippers right there in the holiest room of the temple of God – with their backs to God's altar – worshipping the sunrise. They also practiced Sodomy, rape and human sacrifice to Moloch <a pagan deity)

(God destroyed Sodom and Gomorrah for their sexual perversion. HE also destroyed the Benjamites in Gibeah when they became sodomites and rapists) see Genesis-19:1-11, Judges-19:14-28

NOTES: (Easter "services" occur today, at sunrise, facing east as well. Easter is taken from Ishtar worship – the pagan goddess of heaven and fertility. They used to put on their new clothes, and have a sunrise orgy; and roll decorated eggs as a symbol of conceiving. They would eat sweet cakes and deserts)

(That's very similar to what we call Easter today <other than the orgy>. This man made holiday is an insult to God. God's holyday was Passover; not Easter)

¹⁷ Then he said unto me, Hast thou seen this, O son of man? Is it a light thing to the house of Judah that they commit the abominations which they commit here? for they have filled the land with violence, and have returned to provoke me to anger: and, lo, they put the branch to their nose. (The branch= Ashteroth – a wooden male phallic symbol representing human fertility. This was all connected to Ishtar worship and the orgies in the groves)

¹⁸ Therefore will I also deal in fury: mine eye shall not spare, neither will I have pity: and though they cry in mine ears with a loud voice, yet will I not hear them. (God will judge them all for their abominations)

NOTE: (God destroyed Sodom and Gomorrah. These people in Jerusalem were worse than them. Today the Christian nations are also worse than Sodom and Gomorrah. When antichrist and the fallen angels return, it will get even worse than it is today)
